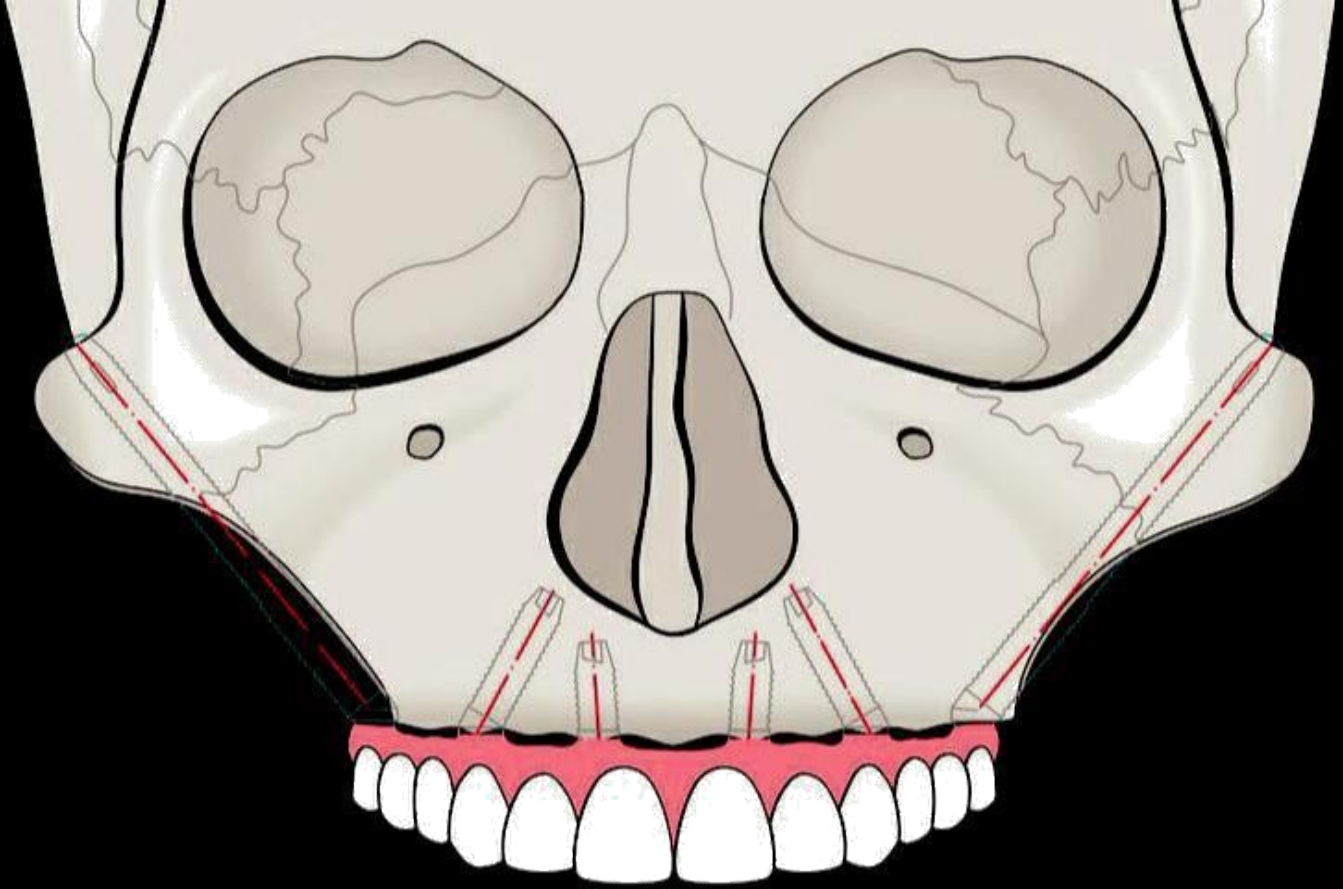

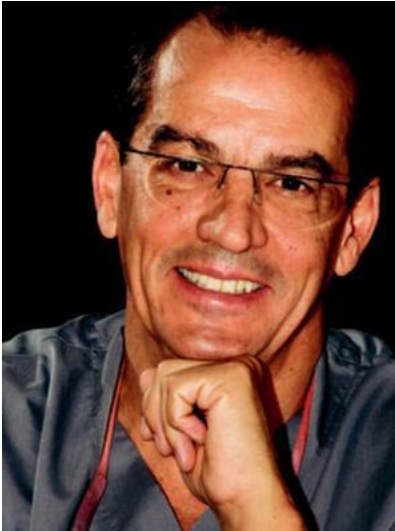

### Dr. Carlos Aparicio

Dr. Carlos Aparicio MD, DDS, MSc, MSc, DLT, PhD. Barcelona, Spain graduated with Honors Summa Cum Laude in Medicine & Surgery at the University of Navarre in 1978, Spain. The same year he entered the Spanish National Health Service as attending physician where he worked until 1981. He completed his internship specialization in stomatology at the University of Barcelona 1983. He further graduated as a Dental Laboratory Technician in 1984, obtained a Master Degree in Science of Materials at the University of Barcelona in 1990. In 1997 he obtained the Diploma in Periodontics at the University of Gothenburg in Sweden. In 2010 he obtained his Master in Biomedical Research at the University of Barcelona, and in 2013 he defended his PhD at the Faculty of Medicine where he was awarded a Summa Cum Laude qualification for his thesis Zygomatic implant based rehabilitation: the state of the art and proposed criteria for success. He has been visiting professor at different universities, including the University of

Barcelona, University of Oviedo and the International University of Catalunya. He was awarded the title of Emeritus Professor in the Centre de Perfectionnement en Odonto-Stomatologie, Provence-Côte d'Azur. Dr.Aparicio is author of several research papers in scientific indexed journals. He is author of several chapters in numerous books and editor of the book "Zygomatic implants: the anatomy-guided approach". He was lecturer at several national and international courses. He has received for his scientific works the Fonseca prize, the highest scientific recognition awarded by the Spanish Society of Periodontics, three times; the annual award Simo Virgili of the Societat Catalana de Odontostomatologia, twice; the prize awarded by the Soprodén Foundation as well as the Prize to the best course imparted at the College of

Dentists in Córdoba and several others at different scientific congresses. Dr.Aparicio is a Fellow researcher within the Handicap Research Group in the Department of Biomaterials at the University of Gothenburg; consultant for the Group of Biomaterials at the Polytechnic University of Barcelona. He is likewise scientific consultant for the following indexed scientific magazines: European Journal of Oral Implantology and Clinical Implant Dentistry and Related Research. He is Past-President of the Osseointegration Foundation of the American Academy of Osseointegration. In 2007 he was President of the annual gathering of the European Association of Osseointegration held in Barcelona. Currently he runs, in collaboration with the Universities of Gothenburg and Clínica Aparicio-Plenido from Barcelona several postgraduate courses on implants, Periodontics and Dental Aesthetics. He is founding president of the Spanish Society of Minimally Invasive Dentistry and has served as Medical Director of Clínica Aparicio-Plenido, the first dental hospital of Barcelona.
